CACF is a California non-profit organization that promotes and organizes educational (people-to-people) programs. *(1) Due to logistics and convenience reasons the trip will start in Miami, using American Airlines regular flights to Cuba. These flights schedule are the more flexible ones to book connecting flights from/to California and other states.*

*(2) In observance to the current Cuban immigration regulations participants who are Cuban-born must to carry a valid Cuban Passport.*

*(3) Freemasons must to be in good standing and must hold a current dues card for accreditation. For the nights of May 14 and 15 we are coordinating some activities for spouses that might travel, at the time brethren are attending Lodge Meetings.*

*(4) Due to the limited time on the morning of Sunday 5/19 the floral ceremony to Bro. Jose Martí must to be held on Saturday instead of Sunday 19 that is the actual Anniversary.*

*(5) Medical coverage while in Cuba applies only to accidents and suddenly illness but not to pre-existing conditions. Travel Insurance is recommended.*
